
# **DVLC Courses**

### **Career Pathways and Nationally Accredited Qualifications**

### **CHC22015 Certificate II In Community Services**

This qualification may be used as a pathway for orkforce entry as a Community Service workers who provide the first point of contact and who assist individuals in meeting their immediate needs. The course covers communication, skills required for people who work in health or community services, working with diverse people, workplace health and safety and more.

This is a nationally recognised qualification to become an introductory worker in the Community Service sector. At this level, work takes place under direct, regular supervision within clearly defined guidelines.

#### **CHC32015 Certificate III In Community Services**

Are you interested in a career that provides customised services to individuals in your local community or interested in learning about supporting the implementation of specific community-based programs? Then Certificate III in Community Service is the right course for you.

### FNS40217 Certificate IV In Accounting & **Bookkeeping**

The Certificate IV in Accounting and Bookkeeping provides students with a thorough understanding of bookkeeping principles and practices. Students are equipped to continue their studies to a higher qualification or to gain employment as a contract bookkeeper or employee performing bookkeeping tasks. The aim of this course is to provide students with the skills and knowledge to be gainfully employed as a bookkeeper. Nationally recognised, this program meets all the requirements set out by the Tax Practitioners Board (TPB) for registering as a Business Activity Statements (BAS) Agent. #### **BSB20120 - Certificate II in Workplace Skills**

This qualification reflects the role of individuals in a variety of entry-level Business Services job roles. This qualification also reflects the role of individuals who have not yet entered the workforce, and are developing the necessary skills in preparation for work. These individuals carry out a range of basic procedural, clerical, administrative or operational tasks that require selfmanagement and technology skills. They perform a range of mainly routine tasks using limited practical skills and fundamental operational knowledge in a defined context. Individuals in these roles generally work under direct supervision.

#### NATIONALLY RECOGNISED

### **ICT20120 Certificate II in Applied Digital Technologies**

This qualification provides the foundation skills and knowledge to use basic applied digital technologies in varied contexts. The course is designed for those developing the necessary digital and technology skills in preparation for work. Learn fundamental digital skills such as using computer operating systems, identifying online security threats, and creating spreadsheets and word documents.

### **ICT30120 Certificate III in Information Technology**

This Course provides foundational skills for a variety of ICT roles. Develop general technical skills in providing IT support services for clients and systems, cyber awareness, networking, programming and web development.

This course will help you build essential industry skills that are transferable across different sectors - including critical thinking, problem solving, presenting and customer service. You will learn how to support a range of technologies, processes, policies and clients.

### Withdrawal Policy \_

Student withdrawal from pre-accredited courses: DVLC commences pre-accredited courses based on the number of students who enrol. Students are advised to consider their personal circumstances carefully when committing to enrolment.

If a pre-accredited course student withdraws before commencement, the student will be offered a full refund of tuition and amenities fees less the enrolment fee. If a student withdraws after commencement, a pro-rata refund of fees, less the enrolment and amenities fee, will be provided on provision of a medical certificate. If there are extenuating circumstances, the student may apply to the coordinator for a refund, which will be decided on a case-by- case basis.
